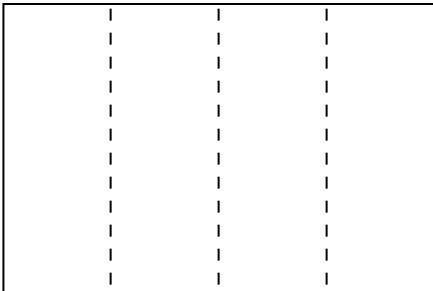


### Materials

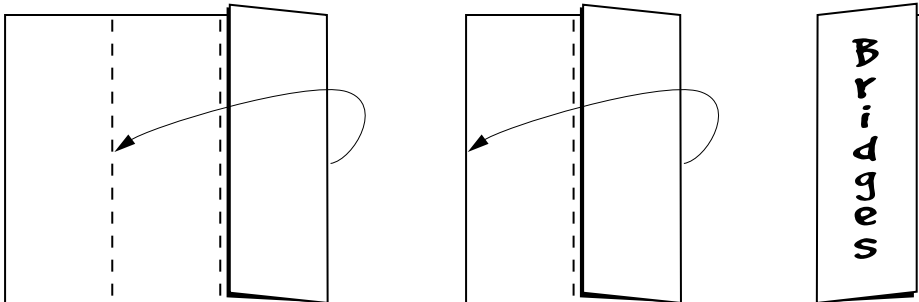
- Bridges BLM pages 2 and 3
- 12" x 18" Manila paper
- scissors, glue, crayons

### Directions

1. Cut out the three rectangles on BLM pages 2 and 3.
2. Fold the Manila paper in quarters, as shown.



3. Open up the folded paper. Fold the right panel toward the centre of the paper and continue folding in the same direction until complete.



4. Write the title on the front and illustrate the cover.
5. Open the book to the first page. Glue the first rectangle to the right panel. On the left, draw the first third of a bridge.
6. Open the next panel of the book. Glue the second rectangle to the right side. Continue drawing the middle part of the bridge on the left side of the page.
7. Open the last panel of the book. Glue the third rectangle to the right side. Complete the drawing on the left. Write the name of the bridge on the top of the drawing.

### Language Activity

Students write lists and descriptions of bridges in the three panels of the book.





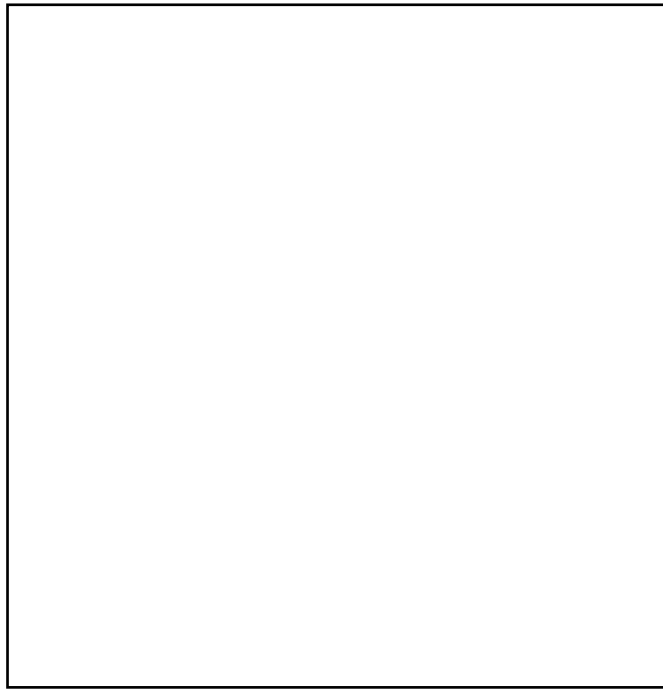
