Activity BLM: A Building Booklet

Page 1

Materials

- *Buildings* BLM pages 2, 3, and 4
- 8.5" x 11" white or Manila paper
- scissors, glue, crayons

Directions

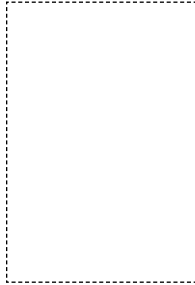
1. Copy BLM pages 2, 3, and 4 onto white or Manila paper.
2. Cut out the booklet pages. Cut out the dotted boxes to create windows.
3. Glue the building top and the building bottom together, where indicated, to make one tall building.
4. Cut on the dotted lines to create flaps, and fold the flaps so that the questions can be seen through the windows.
5. Colour and cut out the roof and door. Glue the roof to the top edge of the top flap, and the door onto the bottom flap.
6. With all the flaps closed and the tabs folded over, colour the outside of building.
