



Different Foods, Different Cultures

Activity BLM: Food Circles

Materials

- paper
- scissors, glue, crayons

Directions

1. Draw an 8" or larger circle on paper and cut it out. Use this circle as a template to trace four more circles.
2. Write about and illustrate a different food on each circle.
3. Fold each circle in half, top to bottom, with the writing on the inside.
4. Glue one half of circle 1 to half of circle 2. Glue the other half of circle 2 to circle 3. Continue in this manner, finishing by gluing circle 5 to circle 1.
5. To display, either punch a hole in the top and attach a string to hang the food circles, or cut off the bottom to make a flat base, and stand it on a table.

Language Activity

Students write about and illustrate the foods of five different cultures.
