Activity BLM: A Question and Answer Spinner

Materials

- *Plants and Soil* BLM pages 2 and 3
- white paper, Manila paper, or light Bristol board
- scissors, spread fastener, crayons

Directions

1. Copy BLM pages 2 and 3 onto the paper.
2. Cut out the two circles and the answer space as indicated.
3. Use a spread fastener to join the circles, placing page 2 on top.
4. Write the title on the front and illustrate it.

Students write their answers to three questions about plants and soil in the blank spaces.



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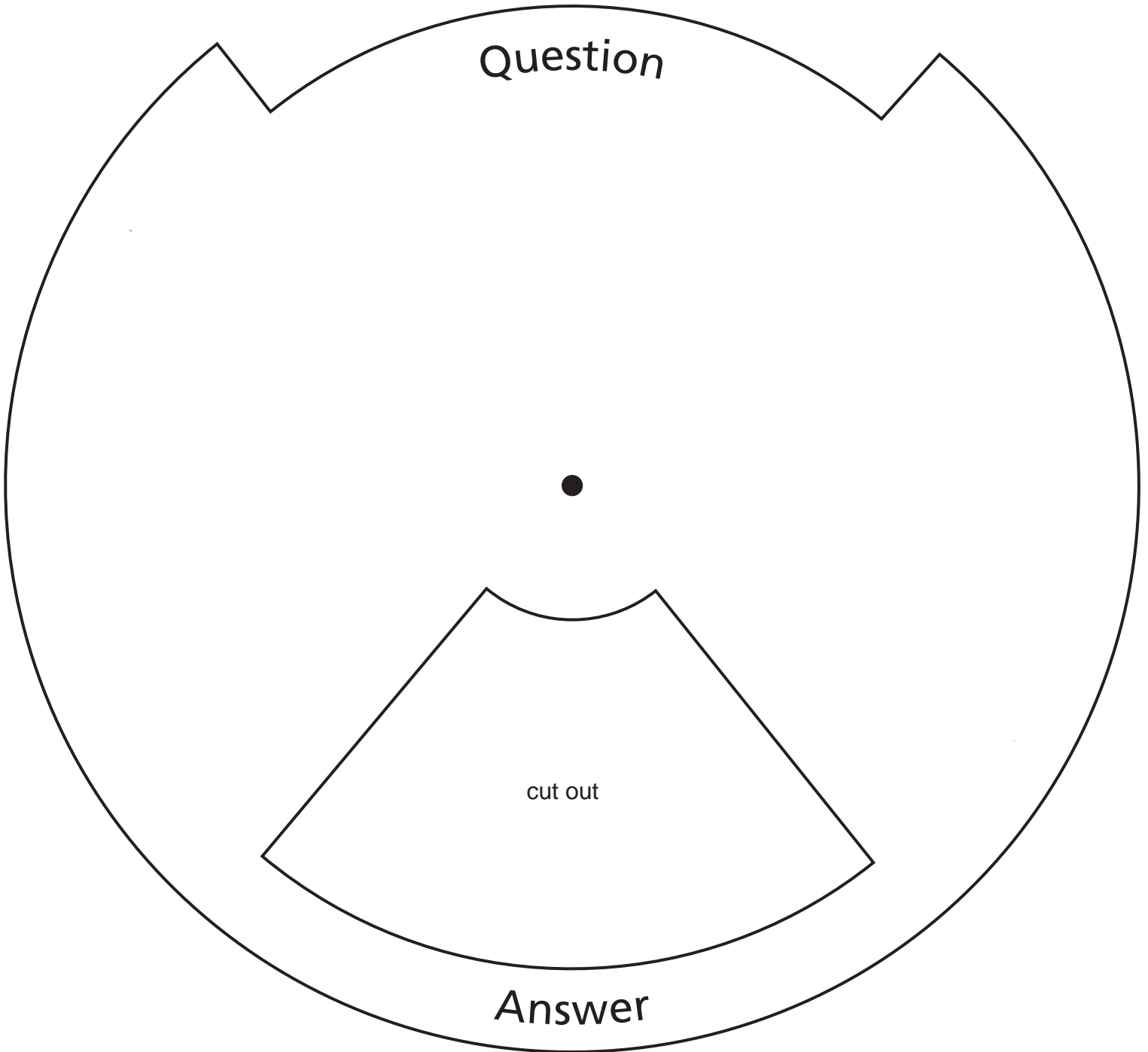
