

Snacktime

Activity BLM: A Sharing Snack Plate

Materials

- large piece of construction paper
- writing paper
- small paper plate
- old magazines
- scissors, glue, pencils, crayons

Directions

1. Glue the paper plate to the right side of the construction paper.
2. Glue a piece of writing paper to the left side of the construction paper.
3. Create a snack plate by drawing food or cutting out magazine pictures of food and gluing them onto the paper plate.
4. Write the title on the top of the construction paper.

Language Activity

Students write one or more pattern sentences about sharing the contents of their snack plate. For example: "I like to share my cheese."
