

# Soil on the Move

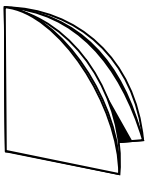
## Activity BLM: A Circle Book

### Materials

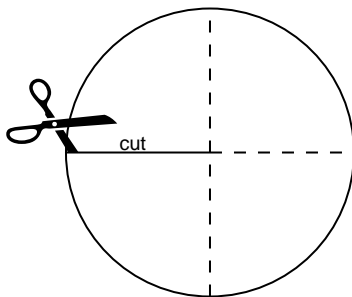
- 12" x 12" Manila paper
- scissors, tape, crayons

### Directions

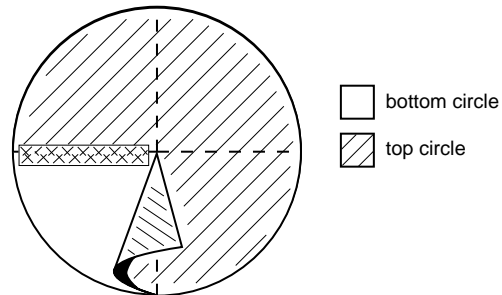
1. Draw a circle on the Manila paper. Use it as a template to make another circle.
2. Fold each circle into quarters.



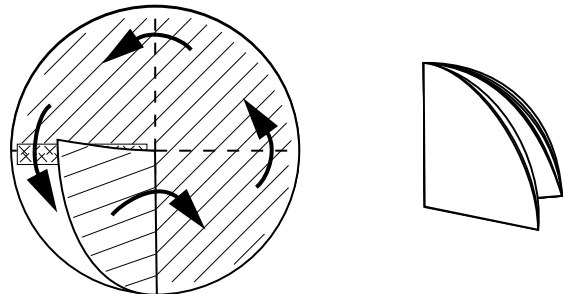
3. Unfold the circles, and cut along one fold line to the centre of each circle. Place one circle on top of the other, with the cut edges aligned.



4. Lift up the top quarter and tape it to the bottom, as shown.



5. Fold the top quarter on top of the section beside it. Keep folding the quarters counter-clockwise until the book is pie shaped.
6. Trim the rounded edges so that they are even.



7. Write the title on the cover of the book.



### Language Activity

On each section of the circle book, students write about and illustrate places where erosion can be seen. They can also include how that erosion occurs.
