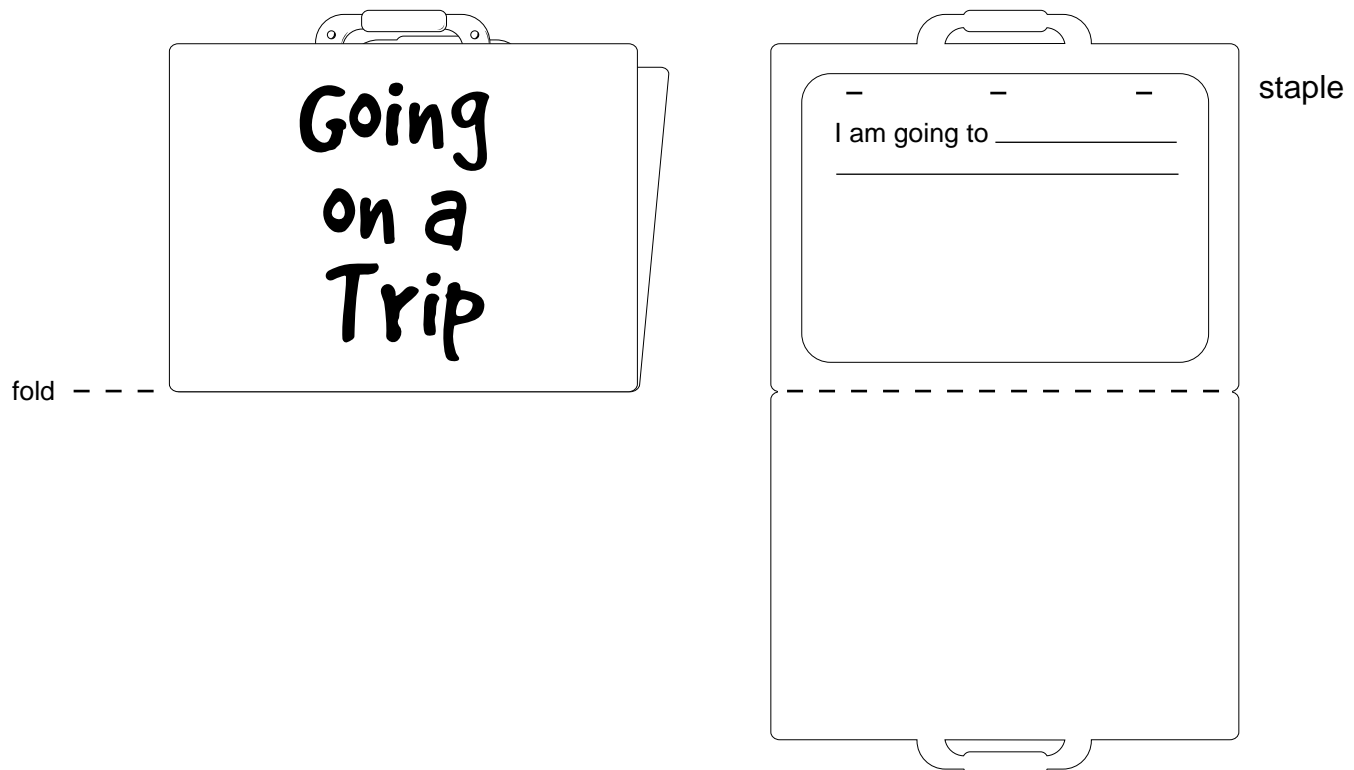


Materials

- *Where are We Going?* BLM pages 2–5
- magazines, catalogues
- scissors, glue
- bristol board, various colours

Directions

1. Photocopy BLM page 2.
2. Cut out suitcase.
3. Fold bristol board in half. Place suitcase outline on fold. Trace and cut out to make book cover.
4. Photocopy BLM pages 3–5 and cut out suitcase shapes for the inside pages.
5. Staple inside pages—in order—to inside back cover.



Language Activity

Students write about a trip they would like to take and make a suitcase book. On page 1 they write where they want to go and draw a picture. On page 2 they cut and paste pictures from magazines or catalogues of things they would pack in their suitcase. On page 3 they tell how they will travel (e.g., by car, train, plane) and why (e.g., to visit my aunt), then illustrate it.



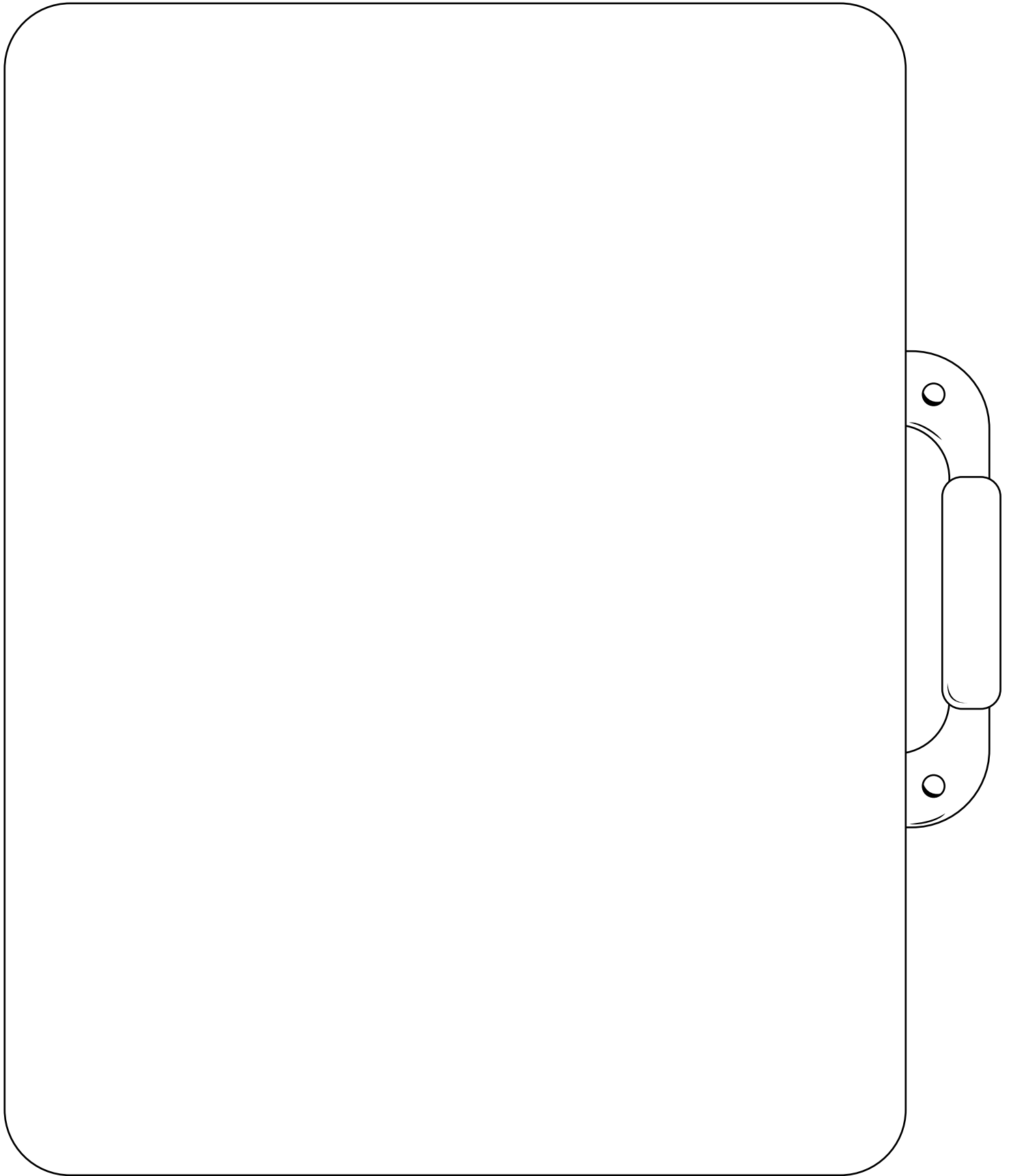
