- ➔ Questions and activities are integrated throughout both the literature selections and skills lessons. In the literature selections, questions and activities are organized into Before, During, After and Beyond.
- ➔ Students will learn about the author of each Canadian literature selection through a short biography, and also why he or she wrote the selection.

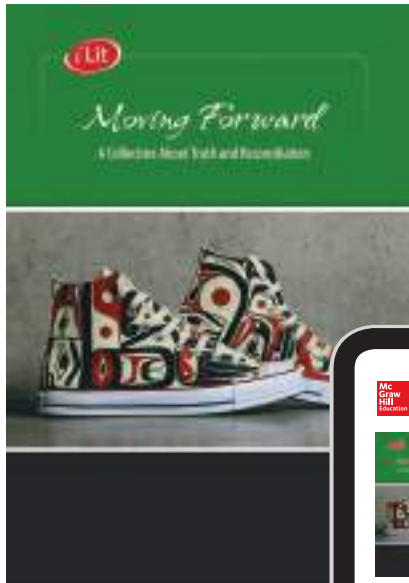

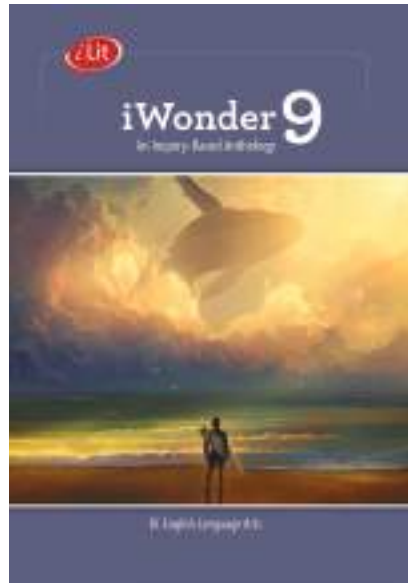

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iWonder 8 and 9 is a new, engaging series published specifically to support the new British Columbia English Language Arts 8 and 9 curricula. Each resource is designed around an inquiry framework, with a definition of inquiry in student-friendly language and a detailed graphic organizer showing an inquiry process. This is followed by two lessons:

- ➔ A modelled inquiry lesson with two BC students sharing their insights on their own inquiry and their final products
- ➔ A guided inquiry lesson to support a gradual release model

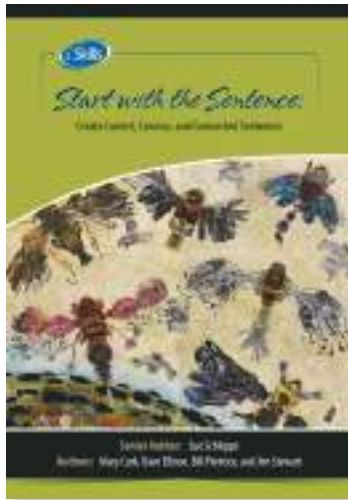
Each student resource also includes a range of approximately 25 short, contemporary literary texts, organized in five topics that support guided or independent inquiries. Over 20% of the literary selections are written by Canadian Aboriginal authors (many of whom are from BC).

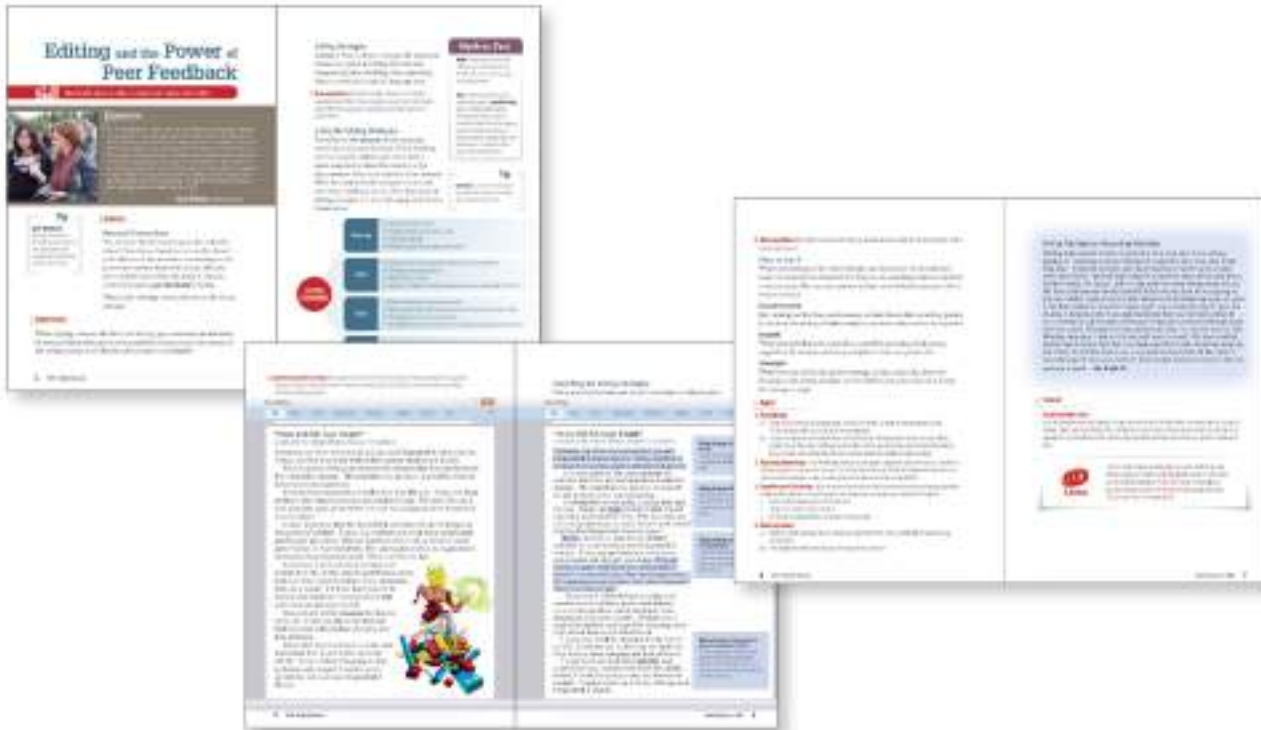

→ **BEYOND FIVE PARAGRAPHS: ADVANCED ESSAY WRITING SKILLS** (Advanced Essay Writing)

The resource focuses on the essay writing process to help students prepare for university. Students will learn about the different types of essays, how to plan and research content for an essay, and how to write an essay including drafting and editing. Students will also learn how to analyze literature in the form of an essay.
